

Cub Scout Shooting Sports Policies and Procedures

1. When you first enter the Barstow ranges to set up, note the way equipment and the area is set up. Note any thing out of place, broken or not available. please notify someone one on the Shooting Sports Committee, list below. If no one is available, notify the Camp Range.
Note: Showing up five minutes before the event is not enough time to set up the range properly, damage shooting sports equipment may cause safety violations and strained muscles.
2. Leave the range better then you found it. Store equipment, place the archery stands under cover, equipment into tubs and stored, all doors are locked and all trash picked up put in the dumpster. If this can't be done, notify a committee member or the Camp Ranger.
3. No one person can run a range safely, and keep up with all the equipment during setup and tear down. Always ask for adult participation that comes with the scouts. Proper set up is a safe set up.
4. The equipment tubs will have an inventory sheet in each tub with a beginning and ending inventory on the form. This must be signed by the trained by the trained Cub Scout Shooting Sports Range Officer and the District Executive Advisor.
5. Storing the equipment tubs can be accomplished by putting them on the lower shelves in the compound storage building and don't forget the inventory don't drop them off at the shop or leave them stored on the range somewhere. It gives the camp ranger more work that he could do without that loss of time. There's always a rush to get the range "shut down" done in a timely fashion. Allow enough time to do it properly....Follow the check list. Ending inventory, and list any equipment breakage.
6. Failure to to comply with these common sense policies and procedures will cause the Shooting Sports Committee to review your training card and could cause it's removal and requested that you take another authorized Cub Scout Shooting Sports training course and in addition, pass the Range Safety Officer (RSO) course before you are able to safely run a range at Barstow, The expense to be borne by the offender/s, both VOLUNTEERS AND DISTRICT EXECUTIVES !!!
